Don't worry! If you make a mistake, press (CLR) to erase the last digit or press and hold (CLR) to erase the entire entry. Re-enter the correct number, then press (STO) and you're finished!

PROGRAMMING NAM 2\*

Follow steps 1-4 for programming NAM 2 also, EXCEPT in the step one sequence press for line NAM 2; i.e., enter P-H-O-N-E (#), then (2), FCN, FCN, and follow steps 2-4 again.
