ENJOYING A LEISURE SUNDAY WITH FRIENDS OR FAMILY MEMBERS BY ADOPTING ECO-DRIVING TECHNIQUES & PROMOTING ENERGY EFFICIENCY

































BACKGROUND

Transport sector consumed 35% of end use energy consumption in Hong Kong, which was second to the 38% for commercial sector, 18% in residential sector and 9% in industrial sector as reviewed in the "Hong Kong Energy End-use Data 2008" published by the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department. Without the emergence of extensive alternative fuel for transport, CO₂ emissions resulting from the combustion of petrol/diesel/fuel gas from transport would remain high. It is considered that necessary to raise the individual awareness of energy efficiency and conservation in the daily transportation, as a continual effort to maintain the energy saving momentum.

In 2006, the number of private cars in Hong Kong registered was 360,000 which constitute 65.2% of the total 553,000 motor vehicles registered in the same year.

OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT

The Event aims to raise the awareness on energy efficiency and conservation of the public for driving, and to highlight the importance of energy efficiency and conservation in achieving sustainable mobility.

FORMAT, PROPOSED ROUTE OF THE RUN

<u>Format</u>: This is an event comprising of the Run with different categories. Under the categories of Private Petrol Vehicles Category and Family Category, winners will be determined by the amount of fuel consumed to complete the prescribed route (route might varies in different categories but only one route for a particular category) under safe driving principle.

Winners of the Open Category and Others Category will be dependent on the types of the participating vehicles with the same principles of the amount of fuel consumed and safe driving.

Route: EMSD Headquarters in Kowloon Bay is the Starter Point, Finish Point and Event Control Centre of the Run. Prescribed route(s) with intermediate check-point(s) will be identified which will consist of both urban and rural roads.

To differentiate the fuel saving driving techniques, and to enable fuel consumption to be measured, the length and traffic condition of the route will be carefully selected. More than one route may be selected for different categories. The Committee will inform details of the routes together with the application results.

Flowchart of the Competition

Participants reach the Starter Point for registration at specified time on 14 December 2008. The Committee will arrange an Observer to sit in the vehicle during the Run².



Travel to the nearby-designated location for vehicle weighting.



Travel to the nearby-designated fuel filling station of the Supporting Organizations to top up the tank free of charge, take record and seal



Attend the Awards
Presentation Ceremony to
be held at around 4:00 pm
at HITEC in Kowloon Bay.
The Ceremony will last for
about 1 hour.

Enjoy free meal and entertainments provide by the Committee while waiting for final results (accompany persons may enjoy these benefits).

Return to the designated Fuel filling station of the Supporting Organizations to check the seal and refill the tank free of charge.

FUEL FILLING AND ENTERTAINMENT ARRANGEMENTS

Fuel will be filled for participating vehicles free of charge for the Run. Participants and 2 accompanying persons can enjoy free on-date entertainments such as free dining, bowling game and others.

CATEGORY

Preliminary categorization are:

- Private Petrol Vehicles Category (with different sub-categories by engine cylinder capacities),
- (2) Family Category (at least two members of family joining including the driver regardless of cylinder capacity),
- (3) Open Category (including hybrid vehicles, diesel and all other vehicles regardless of cylinder capacity) and
- (4) Others Category (to be invited by the Organizer)

ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Results will be assessed by fuel consumption amount objectively:

- I. Based on fuel efficiency of the participating vehicles
- Calculated results: fuel consumption efficiency index ÷ total length of the Run route announced by the Committee x 100 Km

AWARDS

Participants with the lowest fuel consumption under each categories will be given a trophy / certificate for recognition. Other recognition will be given in form of souvenirs.
