

## BMW Recommended *Bluetooth*<sup>®</sup> Mobile Phones



While *Bluetooth* wireless technology is a global standard, there are a variety of profiles that manufacturers can choose to implement in their *Bluetooth* devices. In certain cases, the BMW hands-free system and the *Bluetooth* mobile phone do not share the necessary profiles to work together as a hands-free system. For this reason, not all available *Bluetooth* phones are compatible with the BMW hands-free system. In the chart featured to the right, you will find a list of mobile phones<sup>1</sup> that have passed compatibility testing with the BMW hands-free system.
